VENDOR GUIDELINES

- Vendors are expected to be at the event from 5:00pm to 9:00pm. Set up starts at 4:00pm and streets should be clear by 10:00pm.
- After unloading, it is requested that vendor vehicles not park on Kuhio Highway
- Must first be sponsored by an Old Kapaa Town Business to be considered for vendor status
- Pay fee to reserve your approved space and receive Approved Vendor Placard
- Have available your GET License, and Health Certificate (if applicable) at every 1st Saturday Event
- Must have permission from business before setting up on their property
- Vendor and any associates must remain in assigned space, not obstructing sidewalks for foot traffic
- Music volume level should be respectful to other musicians and nearby vendors. Volume Level shall not compete with music a block away. One Musical Group playing at a time within 1 block radius.
- Supply your own table, chairs, lighting, change and anything else you may need
- Each vendor is responsible for their trash disposal
- All vendors are requested to join the Kapaa Business Association (KBA), if you are not already a part of the organization. Information and online membership can be found at kbakauai.org.
- All ready-to-eat, processed and value added food products must be made in a certified commercial kitchen. All food distributors (whether free or for sale) must have a valid temporary food establishment permit from the Sanitation branch of the State Department of Health displayed at their booth and abide by all rules and regulations as established by the State of Hawaii for safe distribution of food.
- Violators of this agreement will be asked to cease operating their booth and will forfeit their fee payment. They may also not be allowed to participate in any future 1st Saturday events.
- The KBA 1st Saturday Committee reserves the right to amend rules at the time deemed necessary.

Fees collected from Vendors help in the funding of this event including security, advertising, permits, cleaning, coordinators, and all other expenses accrued to maintain a safe community event for Kapaa, Kauai.

Fundraising Guidelines

- Fundraisers agree to follow Vendor Guidelines.
- Fundraising is allowed by registered Not-for-Profits only and must follow rules for solicitation of donations.
- Organization must provide Federal EIN number.
- Solicitation is allowed in designated area only.
- Entering the street to solicit donations from passing cars is a hazard and **NOT** allowed. If this behavior is observed, the organization will be removed from the event and fees will be forfeited.
- If group has children under 18 in attendance, we ask a ratio of 1 adult per 5 children is observed and that the children be supervised at all times.
- If group is selling ready to eat, processed or value added food products, organization must have food prepared in a certified kitchen and have valid temporary food establishment permit from the Sanitation branch of the State Department of Health displayed at their booth and abide by all rules and regulations as established by the State of Hawaii for safe distribution of food.
